

PRSS Behaviour Response Flow Chart

Does the behaviour require Admin referral?

MINOR

Assist student to make correct behaviour choice:

- Essential Skills for Classroom Management
- Zone of Regulation toolkits
- Pause Program



Incident that does not require immediate response

Incident that puts self and/or others in immediate danger

1. Teacher reviews incident with student.
2. Teacher completes 'Major Incident Referral'.
3. Send referral, student (with a buddy), work and equipment to the office.
4. Teacher completes OneSchool incident report as a priority (refer to Admin / Behaviour Teacher Aide).

Send 'emergency card' to the office



Teacher completes OneSchool incident report as a priority (refer to Admin / Behaviour Teacher Aide).

ACTIONS

- Admin takes student to Behaviour Room
 - Reviews incident with student
 - Further investigation if required
 - Determine consequence
 - Provide feedback to referring teacher on outcome
 - Action the existing OneSchool report
- Behaviour Teacher Aide monitors student in behaviour room / assist with plan writing
